The Government wishes to give rural communities a bigger opportunity to run their own affairs, and to set out a vision for their town or village to guide future development. We in Cholsey are seizing this opportunity for all to be heard - even those who don't usually speak up for themselves.

In September 2005 an ad hoc group of 100 villagers got together to kick off the development of our Cholsey plan. We have consulted widely over the winter and spring, and the next stage in the process is this questionnaire, which is designed to gather the views of everybody in the parish. The Parish Council and Cholsey 1000 Plus fully support this initiative.

The data from this questionnaire will help us put together a plan for the parish. Responses will be treated confidentially and we will not publish the views of any identified household.

The population of Cholsey will soon grow substantially as a result of the development planned for the old Fair Mile Hospital site. This is both an opportunity and a threat, but we can influence the decisions which will be taken about our future. The plan of neighbouring Brightwell-cum-Sotwell directly affected SODC policy. Please help us to gain the same influence in Cholsey.

The village is blessed with several community locations including the School, Laurence Hall, Scout Hall and Day Centre. The Pavilion is also expected to be rebuilt to at least provide changing rooms, toilets and showers for the Football Club, and Council facilities.

In addition to the Pavilion site, there are other locations that might be possible. There is space and redundant buildings at Fair Mile, and English Partnerships also owns a strip of land at Celsea Place (off Papist Way). In addition, Wallingford is giving consideration to expanding the sports facility at Hithercroft (close to the Cholsey Parish boundary) with the facilities currently at the Castle Leisure Centre.

## Winterbrook

Even though Winterbrook is part of Cholsey Parish, it is often treated by planning and other authorities as part of Wallingford. Many of the residents of Winterbrook also tend to use Wallingford rather than Cholsey facilities.

It is possible that given the links between Winterbrook and Wallingford that the boundaries could be changed and Winterbrook could become part of Wallingford town. This could lead to extra pressure for new houses to be built up to the ring road. A further consequence would be that council tax for those in Winterbrook may rise to be in line with Wallingford which is currently slightly higher than that of Cholsey (£33 p.a. for a Band D property in FY06/07).

Please also note in answering this question that if Winterbrook were to become part of Wallingford town, then council tax might also have to rise for other Cholsey residents as the income from Winterbrook would no longer contribute to Cholsey Parish.
